25 years of putting artists at the heart of the art

In 2001, a close knit group of Kāpiti Coast artists got together to create an event that showcased artists at work in their studios.

"Art making is a very messy process – we wanted to show people the mahi that lies behind the art people enjoy looking at," says Waikanae Beach jeweller and painter Diane Connal who was one of the 26 artists on that first trail held over a single weekend.

"Artists are often thought of as hermits, ferreting away in their own little worlds. But we were a very strong community who mostly knew each other and would get together after the trail for a barbeque at someone's place to debrief."

Now celebrating its 25th year, more than 140 artists from Paekākāriki through to Ōtaki take part in the annual Kāpiti Coast Art Trail that is now held over the first two weekends in November.

The kaupapa of the Kāpiti Coast Art Trail still centres around the making of art and meeting artists in their studios.

"The art trail for me is still about me being in my messy little studio and connecting with the people who come to see how the art is made," Diane says. "The idea of a 'trail' rather than a single venue 'show' or 'expo' also shows off our beautiful coastal environment and the light that inspires so many of our artists."

While the first trail was entirely artist-driven, in 2002 the Kāpiti Coast District Council got involved, providing significant support and a sustainable base for further growth.

The Council was able to highlight the creativity of Kāpiti further afield, bringing in more and more visitors from outside the region. It has retained an inclusive approach – nurturing emerging artists alongside those already internationally renowned and experienced.

The Trail has gone on to become a flagship event for both New Zealand art and the Kāpiti Coast District. It's very well loved and supported by the local community and now attracts thousands of visitors from ground the motu and even overseas
